

City of Minnetonka Ice Rinks

1. 9 rink sites with 10 hockey rinks and 9 open rinks.
2. 6 paved hockey rinks and 4 grass hockey rinks. All of our open rinks are grass. 5 hockey rinks have plastic boards and 5 are wooden.
3. 10 people assigned to rinks when we are flooding and 4 to maintain once we are open.
4. 12/15-President's Day.
5. We flood mainly with a tanker but can flood 4 sites with hoses.

7. 4-6 hours.
8. No split shifts. We do have 5 people on overnights when we are flooding with some overtime. We maintain the ice 6 days a week with 4 people working 4 hours OT on Saturday mornings.
9. We sweep the paved rinks, mow the grass short, and repair boards.
10. We do not line or paint any rinks.
11. 12-9 weekends, holidays, and Christmas break. 4-9 weekdays.
12. None.
13. After streets and priority sidewalks. Typically the same day as streets.
14. We edge with the belly blade on our tractor or with an ICW crew with chisels.
15. Custom built shaver pulled by a ballfield tractor.
16. We provide goals at each hockey rink.
17. Each hockey rink has board holders but gate boards have not been installed in 3 + years.

18. Daytime highs and frost determines when we start flooding.
19. We provide goals for roller hockey on the paved rinks. We have basketball hoops on two of the paved rinks.
20. Our 5 plastic board rinks are Gameplex by Athletica. They have stopped manufacturing these boards so we do not have any replacements. We are currently planning on replacing one rink so we have parts for the other 4.
