

PERSONEL AND RINK SEASON


- 5 Full Time Park Employees

Dan "ZAMBUNDE" Bunde Flooding the Old Fashioned Way!






EQUIPMENT

- John Deere 4720 w/ front broom
 - John Deere 2720 w/blower and gutter broom
 - “ZAMBUNDE” Oakdale’s version of a zamboni. An in-house manufactured ice scraper. Rear mounted on JD 4720
 - No Zamboni

EQUIPMENT CONT.

- Van w/ hose reel in back, flood by hand off hydrants
 - Occasionally, borrow an edging machine f/ Tartan Ice Arena (school district)
 - Standard goals. Repair when needed
-

JD 4720 W/BROOM



RINKS

- 3-Hockey Rinks / 1-Pleasure Rink
 - Dasher board inspections (top rail, panels, screws)
 - Permanent boards at all rinks
 - Clean debris out of rinks, (leaves, garbage, weeds)
 - We don't install or paint under ice surface

WARMING HOUSES and MISC.

- Open M-F 4pm-8pm, Weekends 12pm-8pm
- Located at 2 hockey rinks, 1 pleasure rink
- Will not open at temps below -10, or when wind chill factors are -20 or colder
- Pickle Ball at Walton hockey rink
- Roller hockey at Walton, Eastside and Northdale rinks



CLEANING RINKS

- Approx. cleaning & flooding process daily = 3-4 hours. Longer if cold enough to flood twice
- If delayed due to weather, a crew of 2 will flood at night to catch up
- Rinks are cleaned after all street plow routes are done. May end up being the next day
